a **Three-bedroom semi-detached house** to rent only 20km from the centre of London. Situated on a quiet road, the house has three large bedrooms, a living room furnished with antique rosewood furniture and a kitchen/dining room. There is a large garden at the back of the house. The area is pleasant with small local shops, a cinema, schools and a railway station all within fifteen minutes walk.

b **Two-bedroom flat** with a garage in a town south of London. The flat opposite a large park and only ten minutes by car from the shops. It is close to the motorway and you can be in the centre of London in half an hour.

c **Modern one-bedroom flat** for rent. It is on the fourth floor with views of the river. The flat has a large living room with comfortable furniture and a large flat screen television. There is a small kitchen/dining area and one bedroom. Most of the residents are young professionals and there is a 10 p.m.–6 a.m. silence rule.

d **Room to rent** in a shared house. A large room is available for a single person in a four-bedroom house in North London not far from the Arsenal underground station and bus routes. There is a shared kitchen and living area. We are looking for a friendly, young person who is willing to help with the housework.

In October 2010, there was an earthquake under the Indian Ocean. It measured 7.7 on the Richter Scale. 1 \_\_\_\_ That measured 9.1. However, 7.7 is still big and it caused a tsunami. This hit the Mentawai Islands, which are a chain of islands lying about 150 km off the west coast of Sumatra. 2 \_\_\_\_ Large quakes hit it in 1797 and 1833 and there was another similarly sized earthquake in April 2010.

The October earthquake caused a tsunami of about 3 metres – high enough to flood up to 600 metres inland and destroy many villages along the coast. 3 \_\_\_\_ This was because of bad weather.

A few years earlier a warning system had been installed to help people escape from the flooding. However, as the earthquake was so close to the islands, the tsunami hit them very soon afterwards. 4 \_\_\_\_

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
