b) MOUNT OLYMPUS

might be a terrible name for a coursebook but it is very popular. It gives a detailed explanation and practice of the Greek alphabet and uses a lot of nice activities for pair and group work in the classroom, especially writing. There is also a workbook for homework exercises. It is best for ages 15 and above. Younger students may find it too slow and serious.

c) Click on Language – Greek is an online course. It's perfect for individual students who have a free hour at home every day. There are dialogues, speaking exercises and fun games which are great for those who don't find traditional language courses interesting. If you or your child can't concentrate on anything for more than a few minutes, you will like this course!

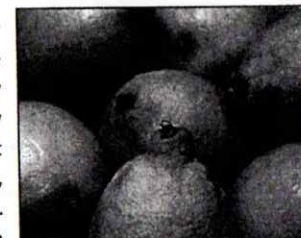
British English and American English
